The daughter of famous poet Lord Byron.

This scientist was chosen as one of the five "Women of Achievement" whose faces appeared in a series of British stamps that were issued in August 1996.

This Scientist sparked controversy as she did not receive recognition in the 1974 Nobel Prize in Physics.

The first woman to hold office in the 330-year-old history of the Royal Society, becoming its Foreign Secretary in 1991.

This Scientist has a plaque dedicated to her at Disney's Animal Kingdom in Florida.

Known as the woman who discovered the Jurassic coast.

This Scientist broke through the glass ceiling in the field of astronomy and opened the doors for women to have a place at NASA.

This Botanist was an adept researcher who provided invaluable counsel to students with regard to research methods.

This scientist became the first woman to obtain a position at the Lister Institute of Preventive Medicine in London.
