1. Motic FunScope Microscope

A 3/4 size monocular microscope with simple optical glass objectives, mounted on a revolving nosepiece. Featuring a plastic stage and stage clips. The eyepiece tube is mounted at a 45° angle and has a wide-field eyepiece with built in pointer. In addition to the bottom light, the microscope is provided with a top light and is thus also suited for observation of surfaces of objects such as leaves, coins, circuit boards, insects etc. Supplied with a dust cover.

- Magnification: x40, x100, x400
- Objectives: x4, x10, x40
- Eyepiece: x10 widefield
- Condenser: 6 hole disc
- Illumination: bottom light LED, top light LED
- Power: 3 x AA batteries and mains power
- Focus: coarse adjustment
